This isn't regular rosé. It is a labour of love. Hand harvested small basket Grenache is gently whole-cluster pressed and sees no malolactic to achieve an amazing rosé. Its soft and light appearance is contrasted by its intense and bright flavors.

Viticulture:

The grapes are from a selection of vineyards at 500 metres above sea level, with poor clay calcareous rocky soil with lots of stones (canto rodado). The vines are more than 30 years old, dry-farmed, bush vines and are hand-harvested at an earlier date to achieve its unique freshness.

Winemaking:

The fermentation took place in stainless steel at 16-18 c°. Aged on its fine lees for 2 months.

Tasting note:

A complex perfumed bouquet evokes red berries, potpourri and tarragon, with smoke and mineral overtones. On the palate, sappy redcurrant and blood orange flavors are complemented by a deeper note of licorice that sneaks in on the back half. Finishes tangy and incisive, with the smoke and spice elements echoing.

Suggested pairings:

As a refreshing appetitif or perfect with Asian or Indian cuisine.

Points & Awards:

James Suckling: 91 points 2017 vintage

"A tangy rosé with sliced peach and pear aromas and flavors. Medium body. Subtle white-peach and grapefruit flavors. Crisp and crunchy finish with some cranberries. Drink now."

Robert Parker: 90 points 2019 vintage

It's a very pale pink and has a perfumed nose with notes of lowers and white fruit. They harvested early and achieved a wine of 14% alcohol (a bit high for my liking), denoting a warm and dry year, but the wine feels in balance. It's quite bright, with delicate aromas of dried lowers, subtle and elegant. The palate is tasty, with pungent flavors and good depth.
